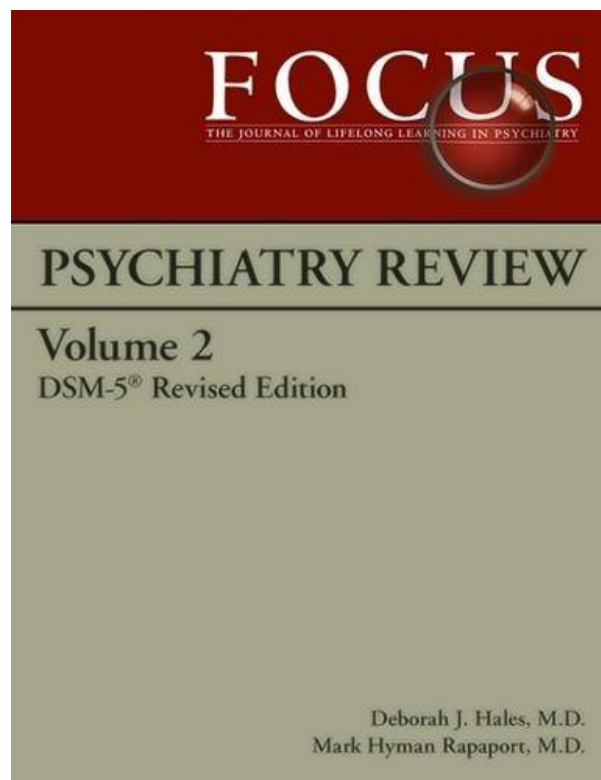
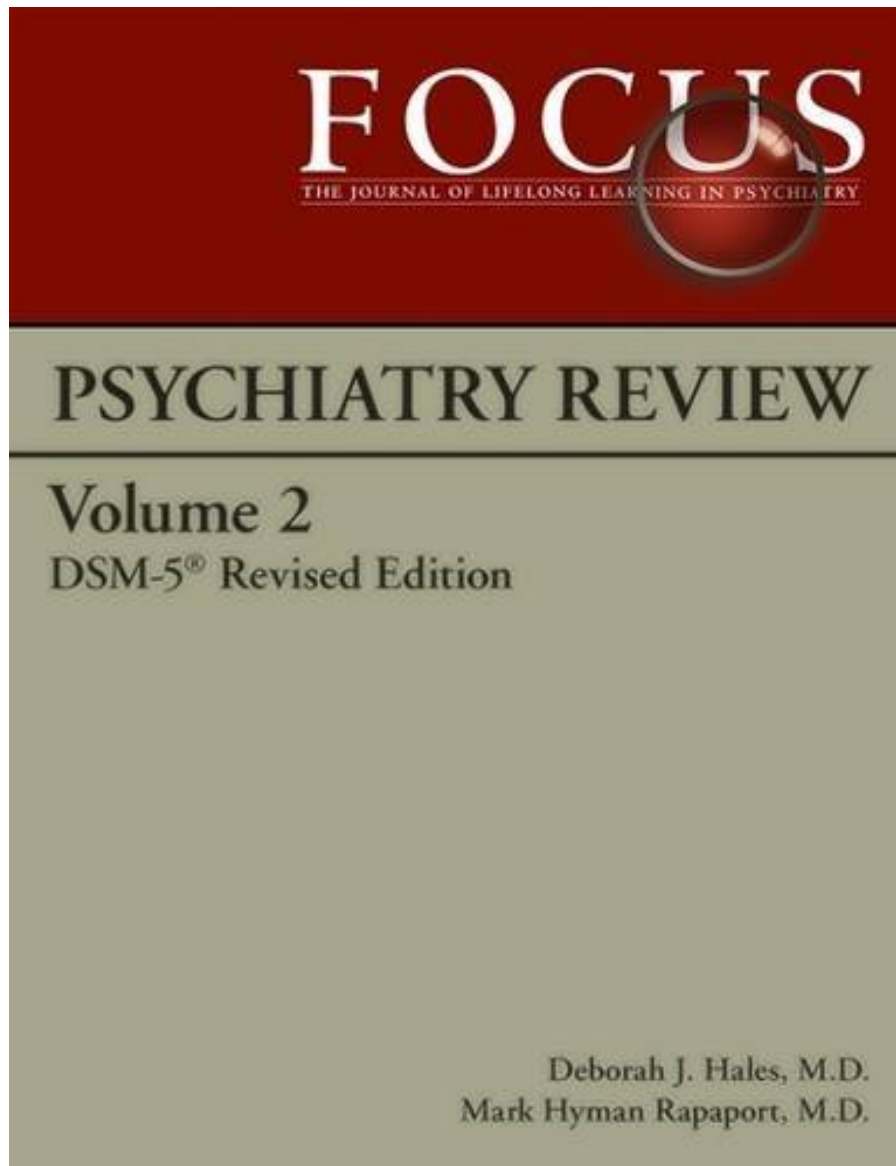

Material is somewhat out of date. This book is appropriate in the sense that it will ask you questions about treatment guidelines for the various mental disorders, however you will find that most of the time it will reference the guidelines published by the APA which are over 5 years old. if one goes to the APA website they even state on there that due to the age of the recommendations the information is NOT considered current [...]. wrt the aspect of it adapted for the DSM 5 there are just a few questions where they ask nit-picky details about the diagnostic criteria of a few disorders--either ones that have changed slightly from DSM-4 or ones for Dx's that are new to DSM-5...not many questions but some. the last part i found a bit frustrating was that there were a few cases of markedly similar questions--almost repeats. again not many, but some. overall layout is adequate, question difficulty was probably easier than what i saw on the PRITE exam this year.
