


As a few others have mentioned, this book IS simplistic - but - it is a good introduction to the subject of digging your own well.

For those concerned that "Digging a well is much too complicated!" - this book will help dispel many of

those concerns. Once a beginner reads through this book, they can decide if they want to read and do more, or give up on the project.

I give this book 4 out of 5 stars because it does what it says. If you want a detailed tome covering all of the minutia of digging a well, this book is not for you. BUT - if you're looking for an *introduction* into the topic. One you can read in a short amount of time to "get your feet wet" so to speak, then this book is a good start.
